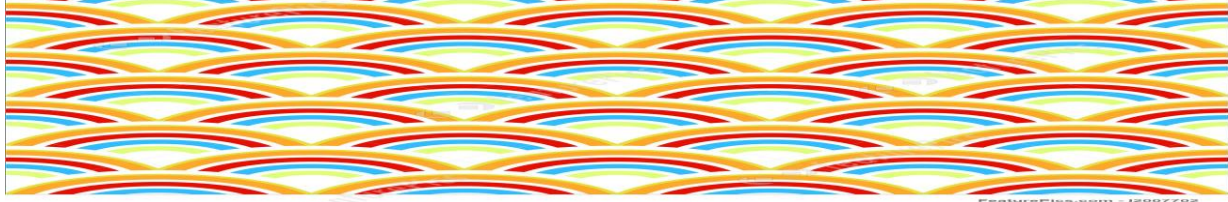


September 4th Newsletter
